Immunization Requirements for Fall Admission

5 DTAP AS OF JANUARY 1, 2008, NORTH CAROLINA IS REQUIRING ANY STUDENT NOT ATTENDING PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND ARE 12 YEARS OF AGE ON OR AFTER AUGUST 1, 2008, IF FIVE OR MORE YEARS HAVE PASSED SINCE THE LAST DOSE OF TETANUS/DIPHTHERIA TOXOID TO RECEIVE A BOOSTER.

Meningococcal BECAUSE WE LIVE IN A BOARDING SCHOOL COMMUNITY, AND COLLEGES ARE BEGINNING TO REQUIRE THIS AS WELL, WE ARE REQUIRING FOR THE PROTECTION OF OUR COMMUNITY.

Prescription Services of America, PSA will be our official pharmacy for all medications beginning August 2008. If your son has regular medications he is taking, and/or a one time medication he may need during the course of the school year, PSA will provide those services. PSA charges a \$15.00/month fee for every month a medication is used or needed from the pharmacy on top of the cost of the prescription. Please bring all prescriptions and over the counter medications during registration to be kept here in the Wellness Center.

ROUTINE PHYSICAL ✓
