Christ School recognizes that the success of our COVID-19 initiatives rests in the hands of the entire community. We've made the decision to begin the year in person and for us to be successful, we are reliant upon you.

It is essential, as we return to campus in the midst of a pandemic, that we are in agreement on a set of shared values and daily actions that reflect guidelines from public health experts and agencies. We must work in concert to create a healthy and safe environment for our community. Please read and understand the following:

- There will be limitations to your day that look very different from before COVID-19. Know that these limitations at the start of school are how we keep one another safe and healthy. You have tremendous responsibility for yourself and others.
- Success is dependent on all of us following the guidelines we've established for this school year. Failure to do so will be considered insubordination, a major school violation, and subject to an appearance before the Judiciary Council, Student Life Office, or Headmaster. It could result in a return home or dismissal from school.

These guidelines include, but are not limited to:

- Refusal to wear masks, failure to honor requests of faculty and staff, failure to honor the residential life guidelines, and more.
- Failure to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene (especially hand washing) that protects individuals and the community. To aid with this, the school has developed an intense sanitizing and cleaning plan for classrooms, residence halls, and other common spaces.
- It is forbidden to coughing on others, their possessions, or otherwise weaponize bodily fluids. To do so will result in immediate dismissal.

Signage will be posted across campus to encourage and reinforce the message of personal responsibility to protect the health and safety of the community. Please do your part to keep our community safe and healthy. We are accountable to one another.
