 - Any other furniture similar in nature to these
- *Seniors may bring a small, commercial grade refrigerator
- Beds, desks, and dressers are to be kept in place. Do not disassemble and relocate them.
- Each dorm will be fitted with an Electric Kettle for ramen and noodles, and a Keurig. Do not bring your own to store in your room.
- Please keep clothing and footwear brought to campus to a minimum. Bring only what is necessary
- Room inspection will be done in the evenings from Monday-Thursday, in between In Rooms and Lights Out.

There will be an added emphasis on cleanliness this year. Dorm parents will be especially monitoring the cleanliness of bedsheets, towels, and laundry, to make sure that our rooms are staying as sanitary as possible.
